Directions: As you come to the station, think about a person or a situation you know that is in need of love. Whether it be a family member or a friend who is feeling down, a community that is full of anger and conflict, or simply a friend who you know would appreciate a note of affirmation, we all know someone who is in need of love.

1. Grab a piece of origami paper from the station
2. With the person in mind, write a small message to them on the origami paper reminding them of the love you have for them and the love God has for them
3. Follow the directions taped on the table and create an origami heart that symbolizes the love for that person.

These hearts will be used in worship this week as a way of lifting up all the prayers of love and acceptance that our community of PYT 2016 has at one time. If you would like one to keep, make a second one!

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
